Art & Crafts Movement Work

You might like to follow up your visit to this important collection at Cheltenham Art Gallery & Museum by seeing further work. A large number of museums, churches and houses open to the public include work by Arts & Crafts designers and makers.

Other important museum collections are in London: Victoria and Albert Museum, William Morris Gallery, and Geffrye Museum; in Leicester: Belgrave Hall; and in Kendal: Blackwell, Windermere.

Museums in Birmingham, Brighton and Cambridge also have excellent examples of Arts & Crafts work.

Locally there are many villages and churches where the work of Cotswold designers and makers can be seen.
